Welcome to the South Bay Trap League 2009 Season!

We are looking forward to a successful season with continued vigorous participation by all you trap shooters.

A couple of changes to note for this season:

1. Fees: There has been a slight increase in the fees and fee structure has been simplified. Please note the Target Fees box to your left.
2. Shoot starting times: To accommodate participants that travel good distances to our tournaments, the standard starting times are now Signup @ 9:00a and Start @ 10:00a. The only exceptions will be tournaments held at Sunnyvale and Newman which will Signup at 8:00a and Start @ 9:00a. Your newsletter will remind you of the times each month.
3. An administrative change has been instituted for the .410 event: The individual shoot trophy will be replaced by a cash award of \$3 per entrant up to \$30 total purse for the event winner. Ties will divide. There will still be a year end buckle for this event.
4. We have updated the SBTL Website. All up-to-date league information will be there. We will now offer Atom/RSS News Feed subscriptions for up-to-the-minute notifications as well as the fastest way to see the results from the last shoot. Handicap Purses

Perpetual Purse \$120.00

To win, the participant needs to shoot a 25 straight from any trap. In the event of a tie, the payoff is divided among the total number of shooters that shot one **or more 25's**.

Perfect 50's \$576.62

To win, the participant needs to shoot 50 straight at Handicap. Seventy-five percent (75%) of the purse, including the fees from that shoot, will be divided **between the Perfect 50's participating at that shoot**. To be eligible, a shooter must have shot at least three previous South Bay Trap League meets between the current and previous years.
