South Bay Trap League shooters just seem to love windy conditions. For the second month in a row, we had "challenging" conditions at the Sunnyvale Rod and Gun Club shoot in June. The "shoot 50" singles format worked very well again and we were able to complete the match in record time, even with a total of 97 shooters participating. Jerrie Haramoto and the Sunnyvale team did a great job running the traps and score-keeping and we actually finished up before 5PM. So, our thanks go out to the SVRGC club members who "worked" the June SBTL match

Many participants have answered our requests to "pre-squad" their attendance and for this we thank you. Unfortunately, a significant number of pre-squaddened members are not letting us know when they will not be participating. This tends to create havoc at the registration desk and slows things down considerably. So, please, if you are pre-squaddened and are not going to be able to attend, please let us know in advance, or even by telephone the morning of the event if it's a "last minute emergency." If we know in advance, we can fill in squads where individuals will not be able to attend with other participants so that who whole match moves along smoothly. If people don't let us know, squads end up with people on their score sheets who aren't at the match and the squad has to wait around until someone can figure out what's going on. A little consideration by every shooter will help all the members of the South Bay Trap League.

We have both had conversations with a number of our SBTL members about the league rules and how complex the handicapping rules seem to be. We encourage everyone to review the league rules on our website ([www.sbt1.org](http://www.sbt1.org)) if you have any questions. The rules cover everything from soup to nuts and are contained in 19 pages. The portion of the rules that deal with how we handicap people takes up less than one page total, most of which is a table that shows handicap yardages based on the shooters average percent of hit targets. One of the major goals of the SBTL is to try to give every participant a good chance at winning a trophy (because we try to give out really cool trophies). To do this, we have a clearly defined set of rules that spells out exactly how classes and handicaps are established, maintained, and updated. When all the rules are boiled down their simplest form, everyone's class or handicap is ultimately based on how well they shoot.

If you are interested in advertising your business in our digital and hardcopy newsletter, please let Steve or Kerry know. We love to have people involved in the sport of trap shooting take the opportunity to potentially increase their business. And it really is quite inexpensive.

If you have not already done so, please send us your e-mail address. ### Perpetual Purse

\$120.00

To win, the participant needs to shoot a 25 straight from any trap. In the event of a tie, the payoff is divided among the total number of 25's that are posted.

This purse is open to all shooters.

### Perfect 50's

\$405.00

To win, the participant needs to shoot 50 straight at Handicap. Seventy-five percent (75%) of the purse, including the fees from that shoot, will be divided between the Perfect 50's participating at that shoot.

To play this purse, a shooter is required to have shot at least three (3) previous South Bay Trap League meets between the current and previous years.
